We welcome all gifts in Wills, however large or small, and we promise to use your gift to support our Parish and its ministry.

Our policy is to use gifts to help fund significant development projects and projects supporting our mission, mostly concerning buildings and equipment. Since needs change over the years, we encourage you to leave a gift in your Will for the general purposes of the Parish rather than for a restricted purpose. All decisions are taken by the PCC as trustees.

We will discuss possible uses of your gift with your executors when the time comes, bearing in mind your known areas of interest in the Parish and our churches' priorities at the time. You can be confident that your gift will be used to make a real difference to our future mission and ministry.

We will acknowledge gifts in whatever way the donor and/or his/her executors feel most appropriate.
